Services Provided:

Rationale

For the past five years, Ruth Owens Krusé Educational Center in partnership with Glades Middle School has offered a generalization inclusion program for middle school students. Students are selected based on their ability to actively apply the academic and social skills learned in general education classes. The purpose of the program is to help students as they transition to less restrictive settings. In some cases, participating students are very successful. In other cases, students significantly regress due to the drastic reduction in behavioral support by trained staff. Additionally, an inclusion/transition option is not available to high school students attending Krusé.

Program Goals

- Guarantee that the student remains at the same high school through graduation
- Fully transition the student to the general education program by 11th grade
- More than 50% of the student's time will be spent with non-disabled peers
- Provide transitional support and assist students in furthering their education beyond high school
- Provide opportunities for students to participate in clubs and other school Activities
- Provide clinical support as needed
