Uniform Policy and Clear Backpack Guidelines

Acceptable

TOPS

Polo style shirts with a collar are the approved uniform tops. The uniform shirts may not be altered or modified in any way. Shirts may not be oversized or tight fitting

Approved colors: Royal Blue, Solid White, Solid Light Gray, and Solid Black.

BOTTOMS

Pants, jeans, cargo or full-length style shorts that are worn at the waist.

OUTERWEAR (Optional)

Approved sweatshirts, sweater and/or jackets must be worn over an approved uniform shirt. Outerwear may not be utilized as a uniform shirt.

Unacceptable

TOPS

Knee length shirts, homemade shirts, oversized shirts; see-through tops; bare backs or midriffs; tops that expose the shoulders such as spaghetti straps, tube tops, and tank tops.

BOTTOMS

Low cut jeans, leggings, yoga pants, lounge pants, exercise pants, pajama pants, skirts, and swimwear.
Jeans/shorts/pants may not have holes.

MISCELLANEOUS ATTIRE

Hats, caps, headgear, and hoods (except those worn for religious purposes); spandex of any type; bedroom slippers; exposed underwear; radios, headsets, or any other electronic devices; written messages, pictures, or symbols on clothing which portray ideas that are offensive to the health, safety and welfare of students; metal cleats on shoes and clothing.

CLEAR BACKPACK GUIDELINES

Level 1 & 2 students are NOT permitted to bring backpacks. When a student reaches Level 3, they will be permitted to bring a CLEAR BACKPACK to school according to the individual with Team permission. Backpacks with gang-affiliated signs, drawings promoting drugs or drug use, and general graffiti are not permitted.
