Uniform Policy and Clear Backpack Guidelines

**Acceptable**

**TOPS**

Polo style shirts with a collar are the approved uniform tops. The uniform shirts may not be altered or modified in any way. Shirts may not be oversized or tight fitting

**Approved colors: Royal Blue, Solid White, and Solid Light Gray.**

**BOTTOMS**

Pants, jeans with no holes, cargo or full-length style shorts that are worn at the waist.

**Approved colors: Khaki, Black or Navy Blue.**

**FOOTWEAR**

**Closed Toe shoes**

**OUTERWEAR (Optional)**

Sweatshirts, sweaters and/or jackets may be worn over an approved uniform shirt.

**Unacceptable**

**TOPS**

**Tops that are:** tight fitting, shows midriff, oversized, see-through, expose the shoulders.

**BOTTOMS**

**Bottoms that are:** low cut, leggings, yoga pants, exercise pants, pajama pants, skirts, and swimwear.  
Jeans/shorts/pants may not have holes.

**MISCELLANEOUS ATTIRE**

Hats, caps, sunglasses, headgear, and hoods (except those worn for religious purposes); bedroom slippers; exposed underwear; radios, headsets, or any other electronic devices; written messages, pictures, or symbols on clothing or jewelry which portray ideas that are offensive to the health, safety and welfare of students; sharp metal items on shoes, jewelry, and clothing. No heels or open toe shoes.

**CLEAR BACKPACK GUIDELINES**

Elementary students are permitted to only utilize a clear backpack.

All other grade level students must attain a Level 3 in our behavior system and be fully approved by staff to bring a clear backpack. Backpacks with gang-affiliated signs, drawings promoting drugs or drug use, and general graffiti are not permitted.
